Tagesablauf

DAY 1: FRIDAY Piraeus/Athens (Ship embarkation)

The Marina Zeas marina is located just 14 kilometres from the city centre of Athens. From 2pm, it is possible to check in to our cabin on the deluxe ship Thalassa. There will be enough time to explore Piraeus on one's own. After three millenniums, Piraeus has developed into one of the largest cargo and passenger harbours in the world. After a tour meeting on the ship, we will enjoy our first dinner on board, our ship will remain in the Piraeus harbour for the night.

DAY 2: SATURDAY Kythnos Island (25 km)

A longer crossing will bring us to Kythnos, which had already been known during ancient times for its excellent cheese and honey. During the first cycling tour, which begins in the harbour in Merichas and first leads to the main town Chora, one can enjoy spectacular views of the indented coastline time and again. Chora is a charming village located on a high plateau, and whose crooked alleys and paths are adorned with painted flowers and geometric ornaments. Our round tour then leads to Driopida, a picturesque town inland, and then back to Merichas, where we will have a swim and can then end the evening in one of the pleasant taverns.

DAY 3: SUNDAY Seriphos Island (28 km) – Syros Island

In the morning, our ship will bring us to Seriphos, a small island situated away from tourism and with deep valleys, numerous inlets and several stunning sandy beaches. From the harbour town Livadi, we will cycle on a serpentine road to the main town Seriphos, whose cube-shaped houses climb up the mountain ridge high above the sea. Travelling through untouched regions, we will reach the monastery of the Archangel Michael, which dates back to the Byzantine period. We will then travel on a panoramic road leading along the east coast back to Livadi and will cross over to the neighbouring island Syros, where we can take a stroll through the enchanting old town alleys and can enjoy the evening on the vast harbour promenade in one of the numerous cafés.





DAY 4: MONDAY Syros Island (34 km)

The town of Ermoupolis on Syros is the capital of the Cyclades, and provides an unforgettable view upon one's arrival. The town, which is constructed on two hills, clearly differs from the other Cycladic towns, with its distinctive urban character. Pastel-coloured houses with multiple Classicist facades characterise the townscape. We will then cycle along the indented coastline through the entire southern area of the island, and finally past the Saint Barbara monastery back to Ermoupolis. In the afternoon, we will continue our journey to Kea.

DAY 4: TUESDAY Kea Island (25 km)

The starting point for exploring the most north-western inhabited Cycladic Island is the splendid natural harbour Korissia. Our cycling tour leads from here, firstly to the picturesque main town loulis, located in the mountains, and then further to the white beach of Otzias, where the Mediterranean invites one for a refreshing swim. We will then travel back to Korissia. In the afternoon, we will cross over to Poros in the Saronic Gulf. We can end our eventful day in typical Greek atmosphere in the enchanting harbour of the town Poros, whose landmark is a clock tower, which towers over all the other buildings.

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY Poros Island (23 km)

On today's cycling tour, we will travel almost completely around the Poros Island, which was dedicated to the sea god Poseidon in ancient times. Shortly before the end of our tour, we will reach the Russian Bay, whose sandy beach with its turquoise blue waters invites one for a refreshing swim. Back in the town of Poros, our ship awaits us with a delicious lunch on board and the journey continues to Aegina.

DAY 7: THURSDAY Aegina Island (35 km)

The Aegina Island is famous beyond Greek borders for its excellent pistachio nuts. Today's cycling tour leads us up to the shrine of the goddess Aphaia. This wonderfully kept temple sits enthroned high above the blue sea, at the only place on the Aegina Island, from where one can see the Aegean Sea from both sides. On our return journey, we will cycle through the centre of the island past the large monastery of Saint Nectarios to the town of Aegina, where our ship awaits us, for the last crossing to Piraeus. We will end our eventful Greek trip over a relaxing and enjoyable evening on board.

DAY 8: FRIDAY Piraeus/Athens (ship disembarkation)

After breakfast, ship disembarkation takes place, which is followed by your individual homeward journey or the extension of your holiday in Athens.
